Always a wonderful surprise to see what folks bring to the swap! But we do want you to know that this year there will be 100 native tree & shrub seedlings for sale at \$2/each, including **river birch**, **redbud**, **red oak** and **indigo bush**, to name just a few. (see complete listing on SCA's **Facebook** page) Also available; **tree tubes** and **stakes** for \$5 each to protect your new trees from deer and voles. Did you know that trees sequester far more carbon than anything else; 48 lbs/year, or one ton over 40 years?

And there will be small **fig trees** available for \$20. These are particularly cold hardy varieties that are not commercially available! If you've wondered what it might be like to harvest **Chinese chestnuts** from your own trees, here's your chance to buy one for \$12—but there are just four trees for sale.
